

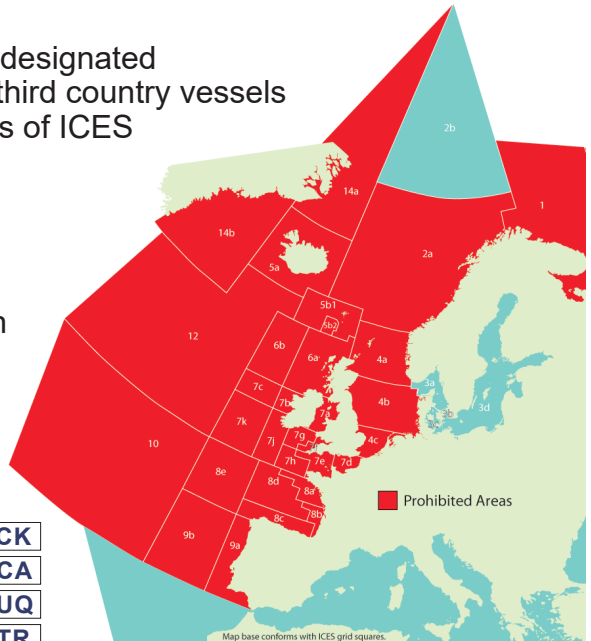
The species listed below are designated PROHIBITED for all EU and third country vessels in EU and international waters of ICES areas 1, 2a, 4 and 14.^{1,2}

They are also PROHIBITED for all EU vessels in EU and international waters of ICES areas 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10 and in international waters of ICES area 12.^{1,2,3,4}

It is PROHIBITED to target, retain, tranship or land:

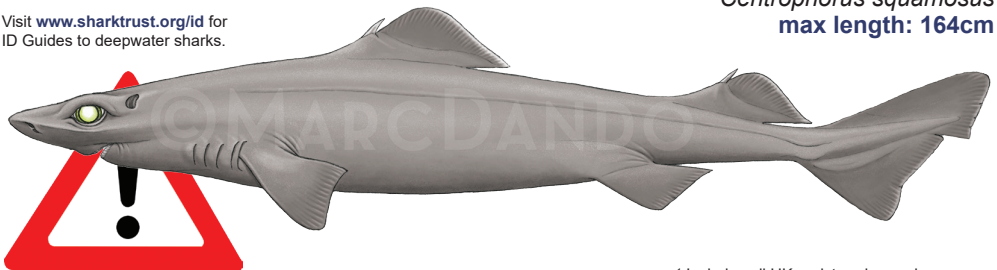
- ▶ Kitefin Shark

- ▶ Leafscale Gulper Shark
- ▶ Great Lanternshark
- ▶ Portuguese Dogfish

If accidentally caught, these sharks shall not be harmed. Specimens shall be promptly released, with estimated discards recorded in the vessel logbook.^{2,5}
