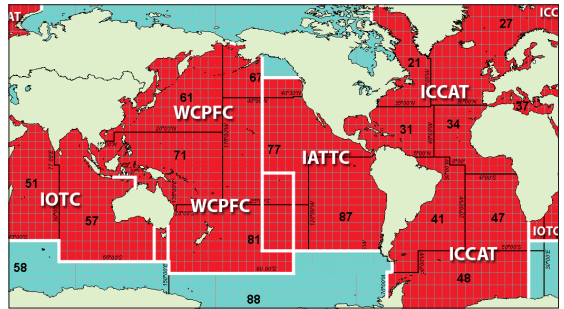


Designated a **PROHIBITED SPECIES** for all EU vessels<sup>1</sup> in ICCAT<sup>2</sup>, IOTC<sup>3</sup>, IATTC<sup>4</sup> and WCPFC<sup>5</sup> convention area waters.



■ Prohibited Areas

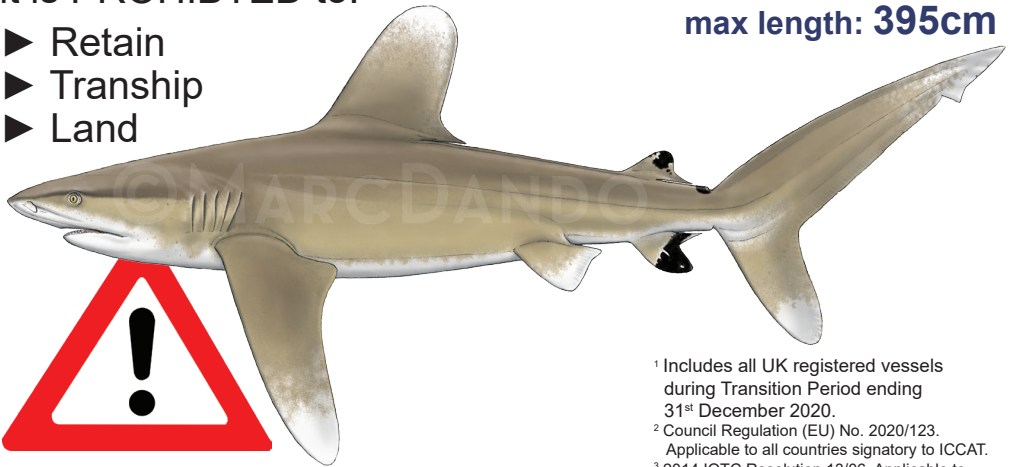

Within these waters it is **PROHIBITED** to:

If accidentally caught, this shark shall not be harmed. Specimens shall be promptly released, with estimated discards recorded in the vessel logbook.<sup>2,6</sup>
