Model A. Consolidation Hub

- Different consignments are brought together at a single premise a consolidation hub. An EU Member State Certifying Officer (usually an Official Veterinarian) certifies all individual consignments. The certified consignments are then loaded and sealed before departure.
- If commercially chosen, and when required, an official seal is applied to the means of transport and certified on the relevant EHCs and the individual IPAFFS pre-notification.
- It is noted that a commercial seal may be placed instead, where an official seal is not compulsory, this information is stated in the EHC. •
- For official sealing •
 - The presence of EU Member State Certifying Officer (usually an Official Veterinarian) at the consolidation point is essential.
 - The Certifying Officer may also require additional information/ attestations to provide the assurances necessary for certification and if necessary, certify an official seal on the means of transport upon loading.
 - Fundamentally, it is for the Certifying Officer issuing the EHC to determine if the correct information has been supplied.
