


## Model B. Sequential

- The sequential model allows pick-ups from multiple sites. Certification takes place at each site, with a seal applied to the overall load at each pick-up point, removed and replaced at the next pick-up point. A certificate of non-manipulation is used to record changes to seal numbers.
- Designed to facilitate pick-ups from multiple sites, with certification at those sites, with a seal applied to the overall load at different pickups, removed and replaced at each pickup. •
- Reliant upon certificate of non-manipulation proposed by Defra to EU Commission and accepted for use. •
- For official sealing •
  - The presence of EU Member State Certifying Officer (usually an Official Veterinarian) at the various collection points is essential.
  - The Certifying Officer may also require additional information/ attestations to provide the assurances necessary for certification and if necessary, certify an official seal on the means of transport upon loading.
  - Fundamentally, it is for the Certifying Officer issuing the EHC to determine if the correct information has been supplied.
